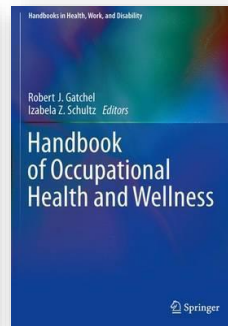
How to get the credits?
